Writing and Collaboration Tools

- Scrivener is a word processing program with ebook and print book formatting capability. Lots of writers use it to develop and organize their books, scripts, and even articles. You have the files so you can send the PDF to a printer, and distribute the ebook files as you wish.
- PressBooks is a browser-based publishing system based on the WordPress blogging and content management platform. It's 100% free to use and publish in ebook and print formats, with paid premium features including premium themes. They will help you for a reasonable fee. They promote BookBaby's ebook distribution service, but you have the print and ebook formatted files to distribute as you wish.
- Leanpub is both a publishing and sales tool. Ir outputs your book to PDF, EPUB, and Kindle formats, and they have an online store which specializes in selling in-progress ebooks. If you're familiar with Dropbox and comfortable editing plain text files (you'll use their "Markdown" formatting) in Notepad or TextEdit, you'll probably like it a lot. You can set minimum and suggested prices for your book, and readers can pay what they want using sliders. It's free to create your book, and you earn 90% minus 50 cents per sale.
- Google Docs is a cloud-based writing tool that's great for collaborative writing and editing. Free!
